Project and construction management

Conversion of underutilized ground floor medical clinic offices to a 1300 square foot pharmacy to service the needs of the medical clinic visitors and the surrounding community.

ISSUE

Creating an aesthetically pleasing retail space complete with updated utilities without expanding the size of the building. A long and narrow footprint, coupled with low ceiling heights, could have made the space feel confined, but through proper planning and collaboration with architects, engineers, trades, and owners, the end space was both visually inviting and had all of the amenities of a new building.
